

Each edition, lasting one minute, brings the explanation of the rights of citizens in relation to various subjects daily.

Castration project widens calls in Campo Grande

Community of Bom Retiro and Vila Nasser will also receive the visit of extension scholars from the public health extension project

The project of university extension “Castration - An action of love and prevention”, of Veterinary Medicine course of Don Bosco Catholic University, restarted in March, will continue to attend to the animals of the families of the Garden Seminary this month of April, Vila Nasser and Bom Retiro community. The service is performed every Friday, starting at 8 o’clock, at the Veterinary Hospital.

“The animals will undergo a screening, which is the general clinical assessment”, said the veterinarian, Professor Dr. Magyda Moussa.

Castration procedures will be scheduled within the week following the consultation. “In females, we remove the ovaries and the uterus; already in males, we eliminate the testicles. The recovery of the animal varies from seven to ten days. It returns home the same day, after a short period of observation”, explains the veterinarian Luciano Barros.

A total of 38 academics from the 9th semester of the Veterinary Medicine course are involved, supervised by veterinarians. “Our main objective is to enable people of lower purchasing power to have population control of these animals, as well as to instruct them about responsible possession and how to avoid zoonoses”, explains veterinarian and biologist Dr. Paula Helena Santa Rita.



The average cost, including consultation, clinical exams and surgical procedure, is more affordable due to partnerships, being \$ 120 for females and \$ 100 for males. More information by phone (67) 3312-3809.


This is one of the jobs assigned to the Design professional, who in addition to making a product or brand known, also he/she thinks about facilitating the day to day of the consumer in many other activities.

- Catholic graduation commissions will sell a special lot of tickets for R \$ 30, from April 6 to May 11.


