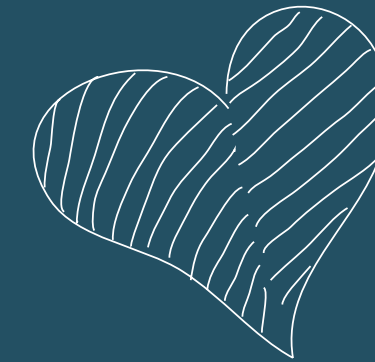

With three new courses, UCDB has open enrollments for Winter Vestibular 2018

Do you want to quickly enter the job market in booming areas? Your choice can be a technological course, lasting for two years, at night! At Dom Bosco Catholic University, three new graduations with this profile were launched in the winter selection process: Technology in Gastronomy, Technology in Water Resources Management and Tech-

nology in Big Data and Analytical Intelligence.

Entries are already open and can be made through the site www.ucdb.br/vestibular. The tests will be applied on July 1st, at the Tamandaré campus, starting at 8am. Vacancies are offered in 34 face-to-face courses and 21 at a distance, by UCDB Virtual.

Gastronomy

The Technologist in Gastronomy can work on several fronts related to food, including planning, management and implementation of gastronomic enterprises, planning of menus, management of food and beverage management services, baking, confectionery, cold cooking, functional gastronomy and product elaboration. gastronomic in general.

Water resources

The graduate in Water Resources Technology can act in multidisciplinary teams and in the identification, characterization and application of techniques and procedures to solve the problems related to water resources in different sectors. Because it is a finite resource, water scarcity affects different economic sectors, requiring the presence of professionals trained to work in this sector.

Big Data and Analytical Intelligence

The Technologist in Big Data and Analytical Intelligence is trained to work in Business Intelligence and Information Technology (IT), as business analyst, social networks and media, analysis of databases in general, organizational processes through analytical intelligence and respective technologies.

Physiotherapy Clinic Graduation and its orthopedics, traumatology, neurology, neuropsychiatry, child health, hydrotherapy and physiotherapy pulmonary.

Nursing Clinic
basic health care for women, obstetrics, child, adolescent and man health.

Psychology Clinic
individual therapy, individual cognitive behavioral psychotherapy, group psychotherapy, vocational guidance, group therapy with people who are afraid to drive, group therapy with traffic offenders and psychodiagnosis.

HEARING HEALTH CLINIC/SUS
oral motricity, functional language, neuro language (applied to children with cerebral palsy or adults who suffered stroke or cerebrovascular accidents), fluency (for people with difficulties expressing themselves, stuttering and slowness in speech), voice work (hoarseness and dysphonia) and audiometry.

Nutrition Clinic
assessment, guidance and nutritional monitoring

Nucleus of Legal Practices (Nuprajur)
civil and criminal legal assistance

Pharmacy clinic
guidance and monitoring

Occupational Therapy Clinic / SUS
treatment for patients who present difficulties, limitations and special needs in the physical, mental, social and educational areas, and aims to develop, recover and / or maintain the proper functioning of their activities in daily life, school, work and leisure.

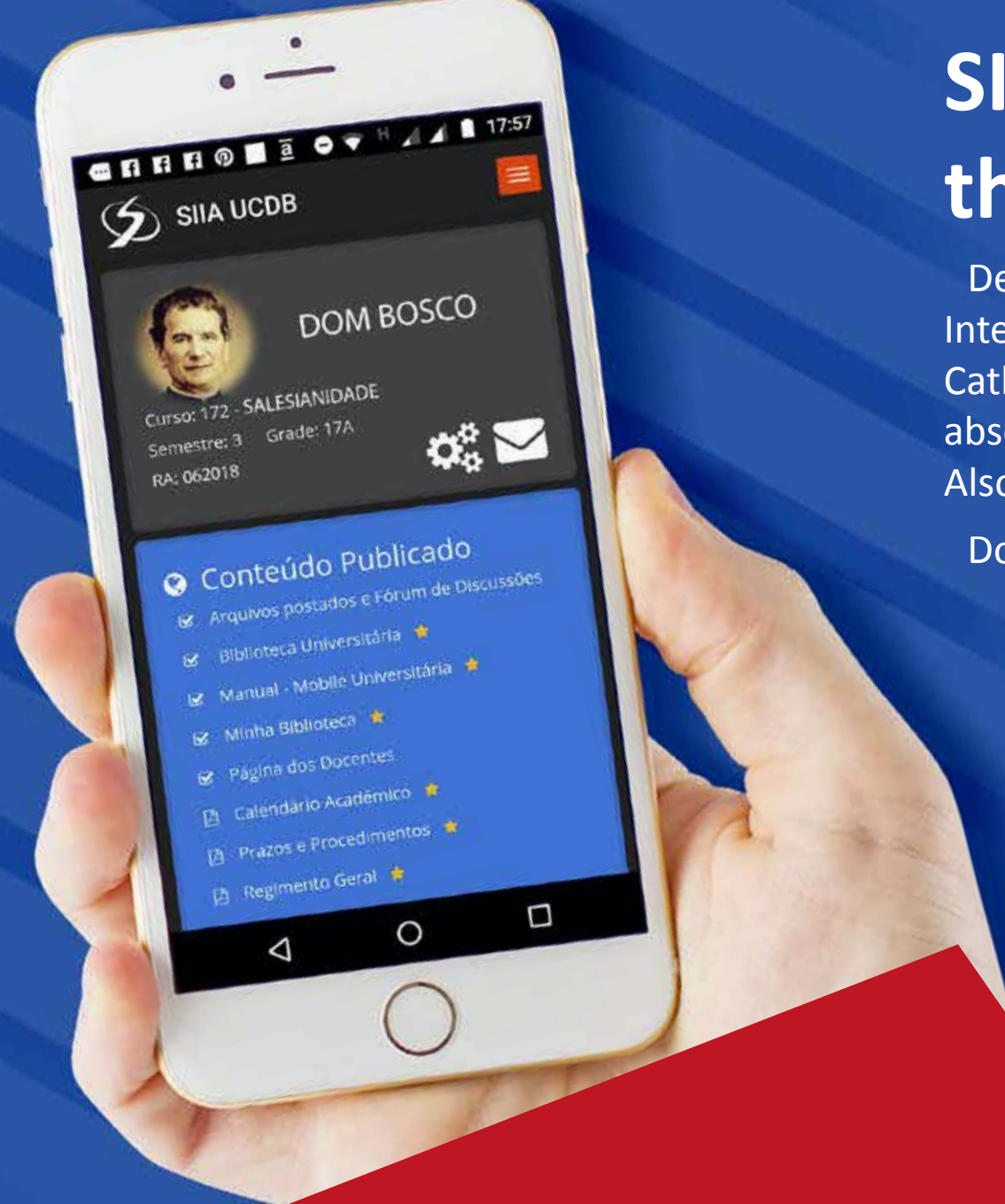

NACNeuro

will develop research on behavior and neuroscience

Created in May, the group already has 41 researchers



The Center for Behavioral Analysis and Neuroscience (NACNeuro) was created to promote the integration between researchers and generate knowledge in the area through studies, in addition to expanding the academic scope within the segment and bring improvements to society.

“In Catholic, when talking about behavior analysis, there is a line of research that works with autism, but in the area of neuroscience, what you see are people who have some study related to the topic. The creation of the nucleus came to gather these initiatives and make the knowledge of one researcher can add to the work of the other, and vice versa, to the development of joint research”, explained one of the coordinators of NACNeuro and professor of the Program of Post -Graduation in Psychology, André Barciela Veras.



The Group has already held meetings and lectures to start the work

According to the professor, before starting the research, the nucleus is in the strengthening phase. The first meeting with the researchers was held on May 16, with the lecture “History of Analysis of Behavior and Neuroscience in Brazil, a future of confluence?”. “We want to promote monthly events like this to generate debate and increase everyone’s understanding of the area so that research projects are developed”, Veras said.

If you are organized, have affinity for logical reasoning, mathematics, and still like challenges, it can be good in the area of systems analysis and development. Within the branch, the professional has the possibility of acting as an analyst, programmer and also as a project manager.

According to the coordinator of the Technology in Analysis and Systems Development (Tads) course at UCDB, Marcos Alves, the functions fit into a career process as soon as the professional is inserted in the market; usually acts as an analyst and then assumes the other positions.

“Analyst is the person who receives the customer’s demands and creates technological solutions to solve the problems that the customer has. For example, do you need a website? From an application? Already the programmer is who will develop the software itself and, upon completion, there is the tester - which will test if everything works. In addition to these functions, there is also the project manager, usually a more experienced person who will follow the whole process and delegate functions”, said Marcos.



WHERE TO WORK?

The professional can work in companies from different business segments in the area of information technology and software and systems development. You can also be an entrepreneur, set up your own company and act as a developer of software products and Internet applications.
