UCDB reaches TOP 100 of the best universities in the Country

In a ranking released by Folha de S.Paulo and UOL, The Catholi advances 49 places and is in 97th place in Brazil



With 56 years of presence in higher education, Don Bosco Catholic University reached the best level of evaluation of its history. In the University Ranking Sheet (RUF) 2018, released this month, the Institution entered the Top 100 and is consolidated as the best private university in Mato Grosso do Sul. In 2016, UCDB was the 146th in Brazil; today, it is in 97th place.

Of the five evaluated points, UCDB evolved in the research questions (115th to 110th), teaching (116th to 106th), market (73º to 71st) and, mainly, in internationalization, which rose from 151st to 88th best in Brazil.

“Our institutional vision, which is to be among the 100 best universities in Brazil, has already been achieved. This goal was for 2022, and it is gratifying to see that we have reached this level

thanks to the performance of every academic community. The issue of internationalization, which is such an important point for the training of our students, is a reality: diverse partnerships, exchanges, research networks with universities around the world are underway, and we only have to grow with it”, stressed the Dean of UCDB, Fr. Ricardo Carlos. Currently, there are more than 200 international institutions with agreements in progress with the UCDB.

The RUF (ruf.folha.uol.com.br) is a national ranking that, since 2012, analyzes data from the higher education institutions of the country. The survey is done by Datafolha and published by Folha de S.Paulo newspaper and by the portal UOL.

UNIVERSITY GRADUATE

Undergraduate courses are also analyzed individually in RUF. UCDB lists seven courses in first place in Mato Grosso do Sul (Computing, Communication, Law, Mechanical Engineering and Control and Automation, Psychology and Social Work) and ten other courses in second place in the State (Administration, Biomedicine, Design, Physical Education, Electrical Engineering, Philosophy, Letters, Nutrition and Pedagogy).

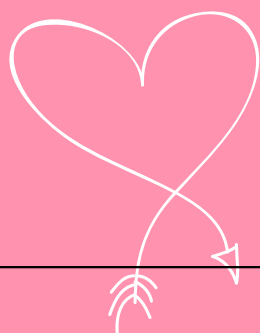

UCDB School Clinic offers free cervical cancer screening (Papanicolau) and a clinical breast examination, which serves the academic community and the local community. And this month, between the 15th and the 30th, Pink October enlarges the actions with lectures, activities to improve the quality of life, guidelines, in addition to receiving the Cart of Cancer Hospital of Barretos on October 31. In continuity with the preventive actions, the Clinic will also make achievements in November 11 regarding the Blue November.

“This action is to emphasize that we need to do cervical and breast cancer prevention because, detected in the early stage, they can be cured”, explains one of the coordinators of the event, Eliny Salazar. Design students exhibit in MIS the exhibition “MS in Colors”

Historical black and white photos that portray aspects decisive for the creation of Mato Grosso do Sul, were colored by the scholars of the 2nd semester of Design of the UCDB and make up the exhibition “MS in Colors”. The photographic exhibition takes place in reference to the 41 years of the State, celebrated on the 11th of this month, and is open for free visitation at the Museum of Image of Sound (MIS), in Campo Grande, from 8am to 5pm, until December.

Under the guidance of Professor Gabriel Ferraciolli, the students did a bibliographical survey to produce the exhibition. “The colorization work of the photographs was done in software and was not totally free. Based on historical research, students took the utmost care of the architecture, clothing, urbanization and vehicles present at the time. It was necessary to interpret and characterize the colors used. We wanted to bring more life to the photos, humanize the past and bring people closer to the present,” said Gabriel.

UCDB Living Experience Project is held in Três Lagoas

Twelve professors from six Dom Bosco Catholic University courses (Journalism, Sanitary and Environmental Engineering, Pedagogy, Nursing, Psychology and Civil Engineering) participated, from October 8 to 12, in the Vivências em Cidadania project, attending an entity in Três Lagoas, 326 kilometers from Campo Grande. They led socio-educational activities

"These days were a great experience both professional and personal; to live with realities so different from ours, to listen to reports of such difficulty make us reflect on our lives.

The idea was to take knowledge, but who else learned from this experience were us! We serve 650 people, among children, adolescents, youth and education professionals", said Professor Ana Paula Zaikievicz.

Among the activities carried out, the participants had actions on entrepreneurship, incentive to enter higher education, prevention of diseases and use of drugs, work on self-esteem, environmental awareness, conscious use of social networks and recycling workshop.
